Entering Kindergarten-1st grade (age 5-6):
Nature's Super Detectives!

June 27-July 1

9am-12pm

With a little help from park staff learn about bats, spiders and other misunderstood animals. We will hunt for insects, look for tracks, play nature games and dig in the clay. Campers will earn an official "Nature's Super Detective" Badge.

Entering 5th-6th grade (age 10-11): Wonders of Water

Get your hands and feet wet during this week's deep dive into the fascinating world of water. Through habitat exploration, water recreation, and scientific experiments, campers will learn the importance and benefits of water. The week will end with an overnight camp out outside at the Manion Cabin located at St. Patrick's County Park.

Spend the morning learning tips and tricks from an experienced disc golfer at Ferrettie/Baugo Creek County Park. In the afternoon, practice your kayaking skills and set out on a relaxing journey to discover the twists and turns of Baugo Creek.
