








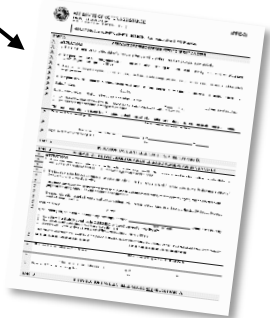


Who and What is Allowed in the Vote Center


Who is Allowed:

-  **Voters** casting a ballot
-  **Children** under 18 with a voter
-  Individuals authorized to **assist** a voter (don't forget: must fill out form PRE-3 before voting!)
-  County **Election Board members** Tom Dixon and Chuck Leone
-  Appointed **Deputy Election Commissioners** to administer official business
-  Democratic County Chairs Diana Hess and Don Westerhausen
-  Republican County Chairs Tyler Gillean and Trisha Carrico
-  Secretary of State Diego Morales
-  Challengers, Watchers (Party and Media) and Pollbook Holders




Who is not Allowed, except to Cast their ballot:

Candidates, Party Volunteers, Precinct Committeemen, Other Elected Officials



Credentials are required by Indiana law, authorized in advance by the County Election Board and must be presented upon request.

Electioneering

 **The chute** is 50 feet from the entrance to Vote Center. This is the *room*, *not* the building. Inspectors will have a rope to measure. Within the chute:

No: Unauthorized persons, handing out literature, yard signs, displays on clothing, signs, literature or other articles that include references to candidate, party, ballot item, or any elected federal, state, county or local official, or any public questions.

Materials a voter brings to help them vote are okay.
